Formatting Guidelines

Paper size should be 8 1/2 x 11 and margins should be 1.5 inches on all sides. Text should be single spaced. New paragraphs should be indented .25 inches.

REMEDIATION STRATEGIES FOR SOIL POLLUTION

(Title should be Times New Roman size 15 Bold all caps, 24 pt before and 12 pts after.)

Author 1's Name^{1§}, Author 2's Name², Author 3's Name³ (Authors should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 12, 24 pt space before)

ABSTRACT

This is the text for the abstract. This text should be formatted in size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

Keywords: soil, pollution, remediation (This text should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font, 6pts of space before and after each paragraph. This is the same formatting as any body text in the document.)

1. INTRODUCTION

The text for the above heading should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 13 Bold All Caps – hanging indent .5 inches – 24 pts before, 12 pts after.

Any body text that comes under this category should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

1.1 Subtopic

The text for the first tier of subtopic headings should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 13 Bold – 12pts before, 12 pts after - hanging indent .5 inches.

Any body text that comes under this category should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

[§] Corresponding Author: Author 1's Name, Address, City, State, Country, Zip code, Telephone and Email. The symbol should be size 11 and text should be size 10. The footnote should be at the bottom of the first page only.

1.1.1 Sub-subtopic

The text for the second tier of subtopics should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 12 Bold 12pts before, 12 pts after – hanging indent .5 inches.

Any body text that comes under this category should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

1.1.1.1 Sub-sub-subtopic

The text for the third tier of subtopics should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 12 Bold 12pts before, 12 pts after - hanging indent .5 inches.

Any body text that comes under this category should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

2. MATERIALS AND PROCEDURE

The text for the above heading should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 13 Bold All Caps – hanging indent .5 inches – 24 pts before, 12 pts after.

Any body text that comes under this category should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

Subtopic, Sub-subtopic and sub-sub-subtopic sections should be formatted as in the introduction.

3. DATA AND ANALYSIS

The text for the above heading should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 13 Bold All Caps – hanging indent .5 inches – 24 pts before, 12 pts after.

Any body text that comes under this category should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

Subtopic, Sub-subtopic and sub-sub-subtopic sections should be formatted as in the introduction.

Figures and tables should be formatted as below.



Figure 1. Figures and the text that describes them should be centered. The text should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 10, 6pts before, 6 pts after. “Figure #” should be followed by a period and italicized. The rest of the description should not be italicized. The description should always be situated below the figure.

Table 1. Tables and the text that describes them should be centered. The text should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 10. “Table #” should be followed by a period and italicized. The rest of the description should not be italicized. The description should always be situated above the table. If a table is too wide for a portrait-oriented page, change the orientation of the page to landscape.

4. CONCLUSION

The text for the above heading should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 13 Bold All Caps – hanging indent .5 inches – 24 pts before, 12 pts after.

Any body text that comes under this category should be formatted as follows: size 12 Times New Roman font. Each paragraph should have 6 pts of space before and after it.

5. REFERENCES

The text for the above heading should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman 13 Bold All Caps – hanging indent .5 inches – 24 pts before, 12 pts after.

References should be formatted as follows: Times New Roman size 9. Each new reference should have a hanging indent .25 inches. References should be single space with no spacing between each new entry. Reference 2, etc.
